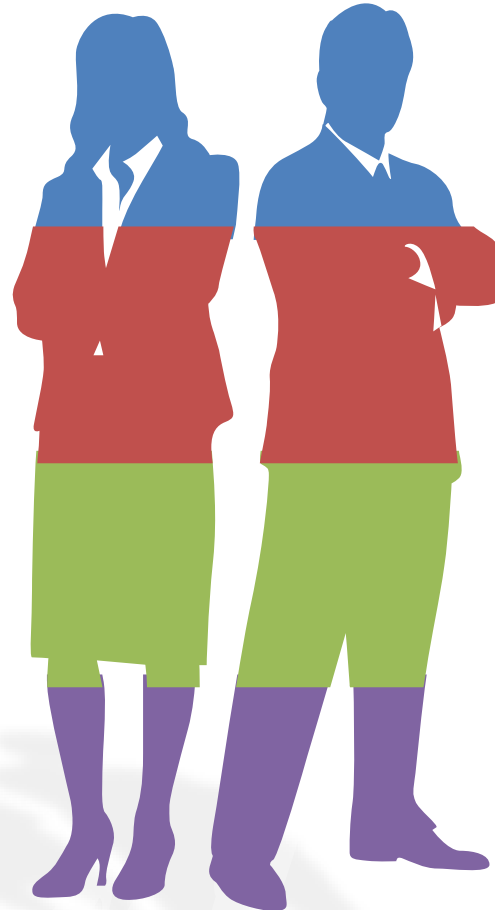

## Admission of the Citizens from Africa (Sub-Saharan African Countries) in the 2021/2022 academic year

Based on the admission results, **697** citizens from **44** countries were enrolled in the Faculty of Russian Language and General Studies and higher education programs at RUDN University. The total enrolment in the 2021/2022 academic year is by **6,25%** greater than in the 2020/2021 academic year.

# Tuition Discounts

## 1. Priority fields of study

Priority fields of study

(Orders No. 1486-p of 18.11.2021 and No. 122-p of 02.02.2022)

Bachelor's and specialist's programmes:

10-20% for an educational programme for CIS citizens;

20% for an educational programme for non-CIS citizens.

Master's programmes:

up to 30 % for an educational programme for CIS citizens;

20 % for an educational programme for non-CIS citizens.

## 2. Regulation on Providing Discounts and Other Forms of Support for Students

(Order of the Rector No. 30 of 17.01.2019)

- ✓ up to 10% of the tuition fee **for the first year of training to children/grandchildren** of foreign citizens who are RUDN University graduates provided they are enrolled in the bachelor's/ specialist's programmes;
- ✓ up to 20% **for the whole training period** may be granted to **children/grandchildren** of foreign citizens who are RUDN University graduates provided they are enrolled in bachelor's/specialist's/ medical residency programmes;
- ✓ up to 10% of the tuition fee **for the second and consecutive years of training** may be granted to **children/grandchildren** of foreign citizens who are RUDN University graduates provided they undergo training under bachelor's and specialist's programmes and have good and excellent marks in 32 the previous two terms.

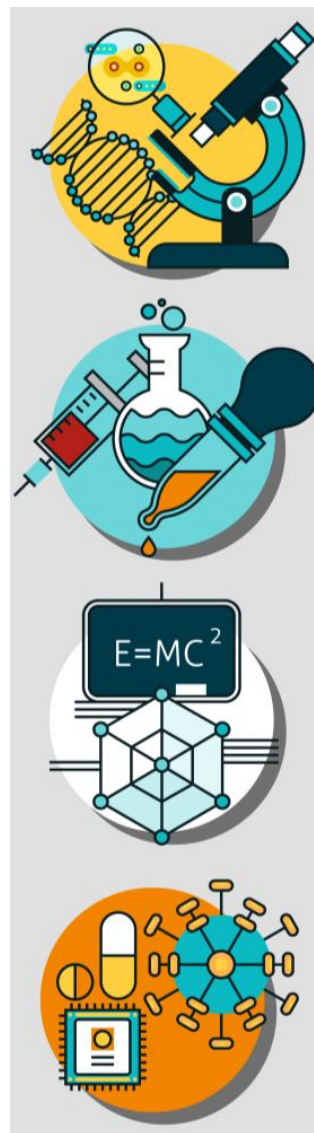

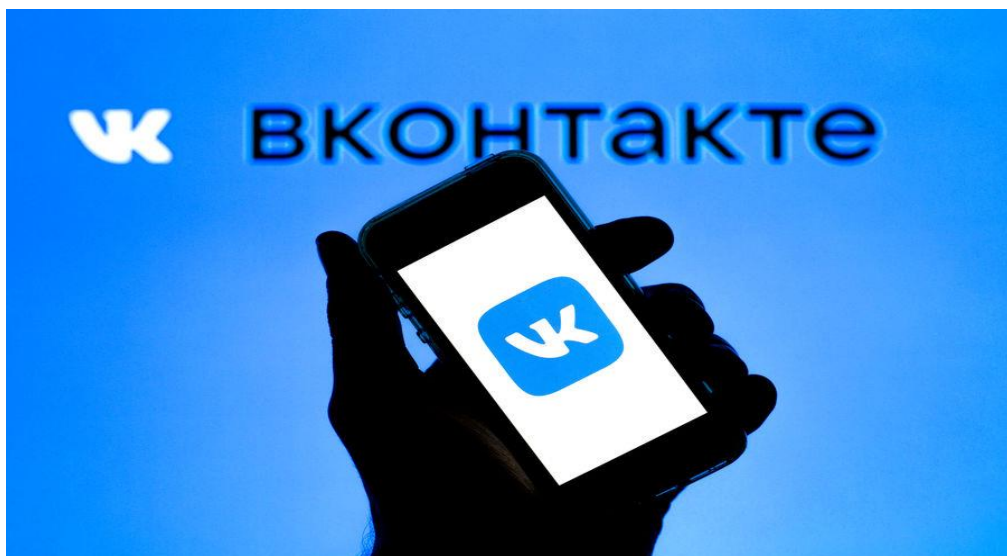
